Our ames sala-furniture which can be used indoor and outdoor is made at the colombian caribic coast by using the traditional knotting technique ,momposino'. The complex manual technique is typically for this region. The pigmented synthetic strings are made of recycled PVC and the steel tube is produced in the capital of Colombia, Bogotá. The handmade production of the ames sala-furniture may take up to two or more days. weaving technique, which are typical of the region.

To ensure the good condition of the product, we recommend to store it indoors and in a dry area during winter.

If the product is kept near the sea, it is recommended to clean it with a soft cloth only using water.
