Designed by Jacob Nitz, the Formosa collection was inspired during a family trip traveling throughout Taiwan. "Formosa was once the name of Taiwan given by the Portuguese - meaning "beautiful island". Each stool acts as an independent island surrounding a central island (the table) - tying each element together.

The formosa collection consists out of various stools and tables in different heights and finishes and is designed for public spaces like offices, lunchrooms and schools. The table and stool tops come in solid oak or powder coated MDF. Powder coated MDF is an innovative finishing technique which provides a high standing product with an extreme durability and environmental friendly production process.




table and stool tops (mdf powder coated)





table and stool tops (solid oak)
